After careful examination of the matter, the Government hereby ratify the action of the Commissioner of School Education, A.P., Hyderabad in having issued following clarifications / amendments to GOs 1st & 2nd read above in the reference 3rd to 6th read above and the following clarification/ amendments to the G.Os 1st & 2nd read above w.e.from the date of issue of G.O. 1st read above.
